A maximum of 78 semester credit hours may be transferred. An additional 12 semester credits at the upper level may be transferred.

These 78 semester credits include:

- A. No more than nine semester credit hours from Health, Physical Education and Recreation (HPER) activity courses, including transcribed intercollegiate athletics.
- B. No credits from courses identified by Upper Iowa University as at the remedial or developmental level.
- C. No more than 30 semester credits from one-year occupational diploma programs.
