This form is used to explain a situation you think warrants a change to your FAFSA to look at only your information and not your parents'. <u>This appeal is required each year until you become an independent student normally</u>. **You must provide documents that support your statement.** Appeals without documents will not be reviewed. Acceptable documentation includes court documents, letters written by someone you know in a professional role or other documents that help explain your situation. Documentation needs to be as detailed as possible.

Unusual circumstances may include, but are not limited to:

- Abuse by parents or other family members living within the home.
- Abandonment by parents whether voluntary or involuntary.
- Entering the United States as a refugee without parents and limited or no access to parents.

Unusual circumstances **<u>do not</u>** include:

- Parents' refusal to contribute toward your education.
- Parents' unwillingness to provide income information needed to apply for aid.
- Claiming yourself on your taxes.
- Living on your own and paying your own expenses.
- Student divorce.
