1. APPLY FOR ADMISSIONS

4. EXPLORE YOUR HCC APPS



When you first log in, you will access **myLogin HCC** where all Highland apps are stored in one spot. Please install the **ClassLink** Browser Extension if you have access to do so. ClassLink allows instant access to all of HCC Apps with a single login.

If you are unable to download the ClassLink Browser Extension, select "Continue to website". You will be required to re-login to each application. Your MyHCC login format is lastname.firstname (no @highlandcc.edu).
