PLACEMENT SCORES/ PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

HCC accepts the following placement verification:

1. Submit an official high school transcript which documents final cumulative GPA and/or ACT/SAT test scores.
2. Provide an official transcript or grade report showing the successful completion of a prerequisite course.
3. Submit standardized test scores - ACT, SAT, Compass, Accuplacer, or ASSET test scores are accepted.
 - ASSET/Compass/Accuplacer test scores must be sent on official letterhead from where the test was administered.
 - ACT and SAT scores can be submitted by official test scores from ACT/SAT or through official high school transcripts.

Successful completion of a course requires a grade of D or higher, unless listed differently. If you have not met the prerequisites, please contact your area college for testing opportunities.

Documentation of these requirements must be received before your enrollment is finalized. Verification due within 30 days of enrolling or course will be dropped. If prerequisite course is in progress at another school, please notify HCC Online within 30 days of enrollment.

If documentation is not provided by due dates, the student will be dropped from the course. Reenrollment is available while session enrollment is open with verification of prerequisite on file. See www.online.highlandcc.edu for Important Dates.

All degree seeking students must have official transcripts for high school or GED and any college level work on file. Unofficial transcripts are accepted for prerequisite verification for non-degree seeking students only.
