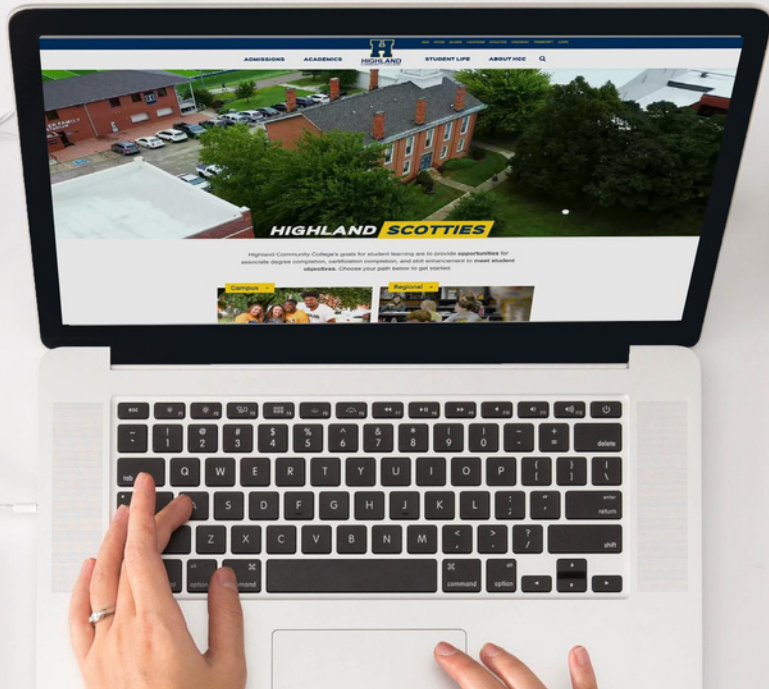

PLACEMENT SCORES/PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

HCC accepts the following placement verification:

1. Submit a high school transcript which documents final cumulative GPA and/or ACT/SAT test scores.
2. Provide a college transcript of grade report showing the successful completion of a prerequisite course.
3. Submit standardized test scores: ACT, SAT, Compass, Accuplacer or ASSET test scores are accepted.

- ASSET/Compass/Accuplacer test scores must be sent on official letterhead from where the test was administered.

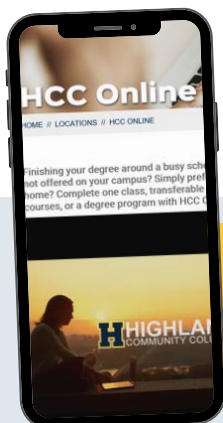
- ACT/SAT test scores can be retrieved from ACT/SAT or posted on high school transcript.

Successful completion of a course requires a grade of D or higher, unless listed differently. If you have not met the prerequisites, please contact HCC Online within 15 days of enrollment to schedule placement testing.

If documentation is not provided by due dates, the student will be dropped from the course. Re-enrollment is available while session enrollment is open with verification of prerequisite on file.

Successful completion of College Biology with Lab (HCC BS 101) or Physiology with Lab (HCC BS 105) or combined Anatomy & Physiology Course (5 credit hour minimum) Must include lab credit

BUS105 Accounting II

Successful completion of Accounting I (HCC BUS103) with grade of C or higher

BUS200 Financial Accounting

Successful completion of Introduction to Accounting (HCC BUS116) or permission

BUS203 Macroeconomics

Successful completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

BUS204 Microeconomics

Successful completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

BUS213 Business Communications

Successful completion of Composition I (HCC ENG101)

Successful completion of Introduction to Criminal Justice (HCC CJ 100) or instructor permission.
