Emphasis is on identifying and assessing a risk and determining ways of controlling, minimizing, reducing, and/or avoiding the risk. Regardless of the industry, companies have to be prepared to deal with risk factors at all times. Students will be able to complete the HCC Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Risk Management in two years (four semesters) with coursework available online.
