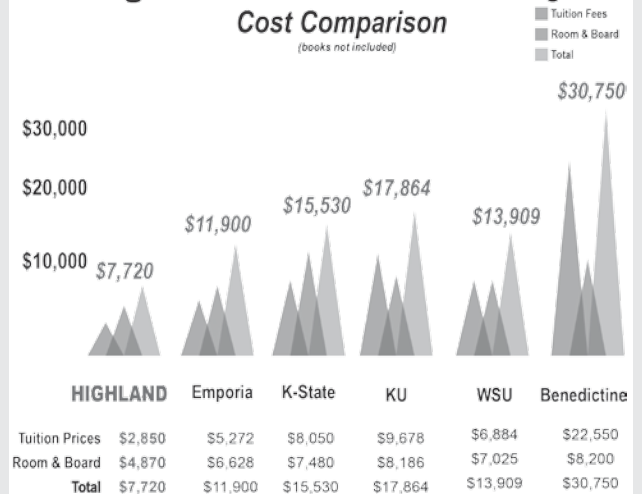

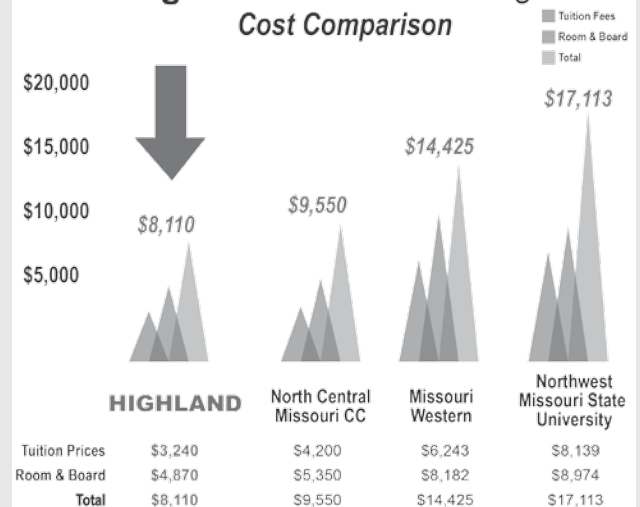

# HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, TAKE COLLEGE CLASSES RIGHT AT YOUR HIGH SCHOOL DURING THE DAY WITH HIGHLAND'S CONCURRENT PROGRAM

Highland's Concurrent Program provides area Kansas secondary schools in the following nine counties: Atchison, Brown, Doniphan, Jackson, Jefferson, Marshall, Nemaha, Pottawatomie and Wabaunsee, with the opportunity to expand their curriculum by scheduling HCC courses in conjunction with their regular class offerings. Students have the advantage of taking their college classes right at the high school during the day.

Highland courses taught at the high school have the identical course content of courses offered on campus, online, and in our regional classes. Classes are evaluated by the Highland Director of Concurrent Enrollment and the Vice President of Academic Affairs before being implemented at the high school. Faculty are evaluated and must meet the Kansas Board of Regents criteria. Students interested in participating in the program should contact their concurrent coordinator or Sara Smith, the Highland Director of Concurrent Enrollment, for additional information and details on the enrollment process.

**Concurrent Enrollment Defined:** The Kansas Board of Regents (KBOR) encourages high school students to take advantage of postsecondary education opportunities by enrolling in college courses while still in high school. The statute commonly is known as Concurrent Enrollment of High School Students in Eligible Postsecondary Institutions.

Highland's Concurrent Program – taking college classes in the high school setting -- is a great opportunity for high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors approved by their principal to experience college while they are still in high school. Students who choose the Concurrent Program learn first-hand the demands of going to college. They experience the process of enrolling in college classes and get a feel for the costs associated with college: tuition, fees, and textbooks. The Concurrent Program experience eases a student's transition from high school to college and provides academic enrichment to students who are ready for the challenge of college coursework. Participation in the program exposes students (and their families) to valuable learning lessons that will support a student's remaining college career. Students who choose college while in high school may make considerable progress toward their college education if the appropriate time and focus is given to their studies. Highland classes are offered at affordable rates when compared to state universities, and students enjoy accessibility to instructors within small classroom settings.

## INTERESTED IN A NEW WAY OF LEARNING? HIGHLAND NOW OFFERS HYBRID CLASSES AND IDL LEARNING.

**Hybrid classes** combine face-to-face classroom learning with online learning. Time in a hybrid course is divided between classroom learning activities and online classroom participation in the HCC Online/Moodle platform. Students benefit from the quality instruction delivered through different modes and the flexibility of both the online and classroom learning environments through independent and collaborative work.

**What is IDL learning? Interactive Distance Learning**  
The IDL system allows students to complete courses being taught at other HCC sites without having to travel to that location. Through a TV and camera setup you are able to physically attend class at one location and fully participate and interact with the instructor and your classmates located at other sites. Classes can utilize lecture, board work, videos, and computer sharing to provide a high-quality learning environment.
