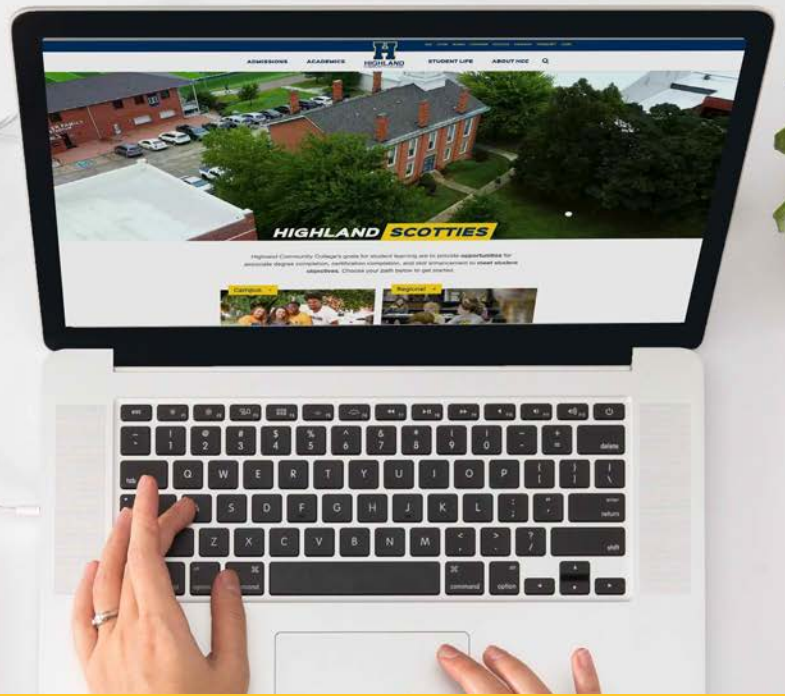

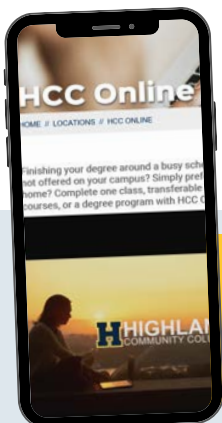
PLACEMENT SCORES/PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

HCC accepts the following placement verification:

1. Submit a high school transcript which documents final cumulative GPA and/or ACT/SAT test scores.
2. Provide a college transcript of grade report showing the successful completion of a prerequisite course.
3. Submit standardized test scores:
 - ASSET/Compass/Accuplacer, Accuplacer NG test scores must be sent on official letterhead from the school that administered the test.
 - ACT/SAT test scores can be retrieved from the ACT/SAT website or are often posted on the high school transcript.

Successful completion of a course requires a grade of D or higher, unless listed differently. If you have not met the prerequisites, please contact HCC Online within 15 days of enrollment to schedule placement testing.

If documentation is not provided by due dates, the student will be dropped from the course. Re-enrollment is available while session enrollment is open with verification of prerequisite on file.

All degree seeking student must have official transcripts for high school or GED and any college level work on file. Unofficial transcripts are accepted for prerequisite verification for non-degree seeking students.

Completion of Fundamentals of Reading/Writing - Advanced (HCC ENG096) and Fundamentals of Math (HCC MAT090) or equivalent placement test scores

BS 203 Microbiology (must meet 1 criteria)

- Completion of College Biology with Lab (HCC BS 101)
- Completion of Physiology with Lab (HCC BS 105)
- Completion of combined Anatomy & Physiology Course (5 credit hour minimum), must include lab credit

BUS105 Accounting II

Completion of Accounting I (HCC BUS103) with grade of C or higher

BUS117 Computerized Accounting

Completion of Accounting I (HCC BUS103) or permission

BUS203 Macroeconomics

Completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

BUS204 Microeconomics

Completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

BUS216 Managerial Accounting

Completion of Accounting II (HCC BUS105) or Financial Accounting (HCC BUS200) with grade of C or higher

BUS230 Principles of Entrepreneurship II

Completion of Principles of Entrepreneurship I (HCC BUS127)

Completion of Introduction to Criminal Justice (HCC CJ 100) or instructor permission.

Completion of Introduction to Criminal Justice (HCC CJ 100)

Completion of Introduction to Criminal Justice (HCC CJ 100)

Early Childhood Course | Completion of 9 hours of ECH Courses (ECH100, ECH110, ECH115 preferred)

- ACT – Reading Area 16 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – Reading 255 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.25 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.0 or higher + 3.0 or higher in Content area
- Completion of Fundamental Reading/Writing course (HCC ENG096) with a grade of “C” or higher

Category 2 - Writing Skills

- ACT – English Area 18 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – Writing Test 255 and higher
- High School GPA – 3.25 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.0 or higher + 3.0 or higher in Content area
- Completion of Fundamental Reading/Writing course (HCC ENG096) with a grade of “C” or higher

Completion of Composition I (HCC ENG101)

HS 118 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Coding I

Medical Coding Course | Completion of Human Anatomy (HCC BS 104), Human Physiology (HCC BS 105), and Medical Terminology (HCC BS 109), all with a “C” or higher

HS 125 International Classification of Disease (ICD)

Medical Coding Course | Completion of ICD Coding I (HCC HS 115) with a “C” or higher or program director permission

HS 210 International Classification of Disease (ICD) Coding II

Medical Coding Course | Completion of ICD Coding I (HCC HS 115) with a “C”

HS 225 Healthcare Coding Practicum

Medical Coding Course | Final course, program director permission required

LG 102 Spanish II

Completion of Spanish I (HCC LG 101) with a “C” or higher

MAT100 Beginning Algebra (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 16-18
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 230-249
- High School GPA – 2.75 or lower
- Completion of Fundamentals of Math (HCC MAT090) with a “CR” grade

MAT103 Intermediate Algebra (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 19-21
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 250-262
- High School GPA – 2.75 or higher + Algebra I with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) with a grade of “C” or higher

MAT104 College Algebra (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 22 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 263 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.00 or higher + Algebra II with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of Intermediate Algebra (HCC MAT103) with a grade of “C” or higher

MAT106 Calculus I (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 25 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – AAF Test 276 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.00 or higher + HS Trig/Pre-Calc with a grade of “C” or higher
- Successful completion of Trigonometry (HCC MAT105) with a grade of “C” or higher

MAT203 Basic Statistics

- ACT – Mathematics Area 22 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 263 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.00 or higher + Algebra II with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of College Algebra (HCC MAT104) with a grade of “C” or higher

PS 101 College Physical Science with Lab

Completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

PSY202 Child Psychology

Completion of General Psychology (HCC PSY101)
