HIGHLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES' REVENUE NEUTRAL HEARING August 24, 2022

<u>Trustees Present</u>: Vernie Coy, Russel Karn, Kenneth Huss, Thomas Smith, Jason Taylor, Carl Tharman.

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Smith at 6:30 p.m. in the Highland Community College David Reist Administration Building Conference Room.

<u>Open Revenue Neutral Hearing</u>: Chairperson Smith declared the 2022-2023 Revenue Neutral Hearing to be open.

<u>Public Comments</u>: Chairperson Smith asked for public comment regarding the 2021-2022 Revenue Neutral Hearing. Public comment was heard from John Kiehnhoff and Joan Nimtz.

President Fox explained that the resolution expresses the property taxation policy of Highland Community College with respect to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Tax Rate for financing the annual budget for 2022-2023.

Whereas, 2021 SB 13 and Senate Sub for HB 2104, provides that a levy of property taxes to finance the 2022-2023 budget for Highland Community College be authorized by resolution.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by Highland Community College that the 2022-2023 budget with a levy of property taxes exceeding the Revenue Neutral Tax Rates calculated for 2022-2023, as adjusted pursuant to 2021 SB 12 and Senate Sub for HB 2104 is hereby adopted.

Adopted this 24 day of August, 2022 by Highland Community College, Doniphan County, Kansas.

It was moved by Mr. Huss, seconded by Mr. Taylor, that Resolution Number 8-24-2022 be adopted by Highland Community College. Motion passed.
