

HCC offers online courses designed specifically for the high school student. These courses are transferable and may be taken for dual credit. Contact your high school counselor for dual credit options available to you!

High school students can earn college credits completely online through HCC's online program. High school students who have completed their freshman year can enroll in HCC courses; however, the Excel in CTE funding is available only to juniors and seniors. Courses are taught by experienced faculty and provide students the opportunity to get a head start on their college degree or jump start their career.

Although these classes will have only online instruction, we encourage students enrolling to have access to a teacher at their school for support and assistance to ensure student success.

We will be offering these online classes for high school enrollment only. Additionally, they are taught by an instructor with experience teaching high school students, so they understand the unique needs and schedule of our high school students. The classes offer the same curriculum as our other online options. Some classes have consumable item fees. Seats are limited.
