

HOW TO APPLY

- Print off the instructor Recommendation Form.
- Give the form and an envelope to an instructor who will serve as your reference.
- Return the sealed envelope and include the instructor's signature across the back flap once completed.
- Answer the following 3 questions:
 (Each question should be answered with approximately 150 words in a
 LEGIBLY typed document that includes your name and regional center.)
 - 1. Explain the importance of your major or area of interest in our society.
 - 2. Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that sets you apart.
 - 3. State any personal or family circumstances affecting your need for this scholarship.

Recommendation and application should be received by your Regional Director no later than **April 17.** Award recipients will be notified May 9, 2024.

IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS CONCERNING THIS SCHOLARSHIP, PLEASE CONSULT WITH YOUR REGIONAL DIRECTOR.

ELIGIBILITY

- Be a Kansas resident.
- Earned a high school diploma or GED by the start of the scholarship.
- Completed or be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours of HCC coursework with an overall GPA of 2.5.
- Be degree seeking with Highland Community College.
- Scholarship available for the fall and spring semesters only.
- Scholarship may not be used for HCC Online or technical programs at the Technical Center in Atchison.

Up to two students may be selected from each Regional Center. Chosen students will receive a scholarship covering tuition + book rental for six credit hours per semester. Recipients must take a minimum of six credit hours at any Regional Center.
